## **CONDITIONS OF AGREEMENT**

Broward College offers an LPN-RN Transition track for Florida Licensed Practical Nurses who hold a current Florida LPN license, without restrictions/obligations/public complaint. The LPN-RN Transition track is designed to recognize the Florida Licensed Practical Nurses' knowledge and skill level and provides them the opportunity to receive experiential learning credits for NUR 1020/NUR 1020L and NUR 1210/NUR1210L. The LPN-RN Transition student includes 728 hours of clinical experience as compared to the 1008 clinical hours included in the Generic Track. The Broward College Associate Dean for Nursing prepares the documents necessary for the submission of experiential learning credits.

To be eligible for award of experiential learning credits at Broward College, student must:

- Meet requirements for admission to Broward College.
- Meet requirements for admission to the Broward College Associate of Science Degree Nursing Program, specially the LPN-RN Transition Track (Major Code 21271) effective at the time of application to the Broward College Nursing Program.
- Be an LPN-RN Transition nursing student in good standing and currently enrolled in the Broward College Associate of Science Degree Nursing Program, LPN-RN Transition Track (Major Code 21271).
